IMPORTANT NOTE: If you and your spouse are separated/living apart and have already agreed upon the division of certain Household Items and/or other Personal Property **AND** both of you currently have those items in your possession, **YOU WILL NOT NEED TO LIST THOSE ITEMS** in your interview. However, you will need to list any and all of the following (even if you have already agreed upon the division of these items):

1. Real Property
2. Vehicles
3. Joint Financial Accounts
4. Retirement Accounts
